#### **Composition Camp**

Students (ages 6 – 12) enrolled in our Composition Camp are seeking to build stronger compositions skills, music history knowledge and a chance to share their passion for music with other aspiring composers. Each student submitted a score prior to starting camp. Throughout their camp, students receive coaching from MacPhail composition faculty. In addition to composing, students are studying the works of living and historic composers to understand how composers think and solve problems.

At the dress rehearsal and final performances, student composers will talk about the composition process and what has inspired their piece. They will also have the opportunity to hear their compositions performed by professional musicians.
