Elizabeth Drueding Voice Scholarship

The Elizabeth Drueding Voice Scholarship is intended for a high school voice student. The student must demonstrate financial need and commitment as demonstrated through an audition. MacPhail Center for Music has one (1) scholarship in the amount of \$1000 to award to a student enrolled in voice lessons at MacPhail, with the award divided between the 2023-2024 fall and spring semesters, (\$500 for fall, \$500 for spring.) Students must submit video links of their recorded audition pieces as well as provide a summary page of their parents'/guardians' most recent tax return. A letter of recommendation from a teacher is also required.

Application Deadline: Monday, October 30 by 5:00pm

Age Requirement: 14-18

Instrument Requirement: Voice

Maximum Audition Video Time: 12 minutes

MacPHAIL SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION GUIDELINES

TIME LIMIT

- Maximum audition time is **12 minutes**.
- Students may record 1-2 pieces.
- Videos must be uploaded to YouTube with the visibility settings as unlisted.

ACCOMPANISTS & FEES

- There is no audition fee for this scholarship audition.
- Students may use pre-recorded tracks for their audition video or use an accompanist.
- **\$30.00 audition accompanist fee** is required of any students wishing to use the services of a MacPhail staff accompanist for their audition. This fee is not subject to a financial aid waiver and should be paid upon submitting this application.
- If you plan to have a MacPhail staff accompanist play for your audition, you must pay the audition accompanist fee as indicated above *and* submit a MacPhail Staff Accompanist Request Form prior to the application deadline. Both the form and the payment can be submitted online.
- Students may choose to select their own accompanist for the audition at their own expense.

OTHER DETAILS

- Applications must include the following: completed application form, teacher recommendation, audition video link/s and summary page of the your parents'/guardians' most recent tax return.
- All students who apply will receive an **email** detailing the results of their audition.
- The adjudicator's comment sheets will be given or e-mailed to either you or your instructor.
