## Financial Aid Award Guidelines Financial aid awards are based on need and available aid resources. Qualifying applicants are awarded on a first come first serve basis until funds are depleted. The amount of financial aid is determined by a sliding scale which takes into account household income and number of exemptions. Awards are tent functions to \$77,000 with 10 exemptions. Example: families with an income level of \$52,000 and 5 exemptions would receive 40%

granted for income levels up to \$78,999 with 10 exemptions. Example: families with an income level of \$52,000 and 5 exemptions would receive 40% financial aid toward tuition with completed application turned in by the deadline.
